



Please review the flyer from your child's school for the WoWScience adventures offered.

There is NOT a registration fee for the WoWScience adventures; however, new students who join the adventures and continue in the science club during the academic year will need to pay the \$35 new member registration fee for the science club, which includes a lab coat. Only those that have paid a member's fee qualify for the discounted returning member's registration fee of \$15, as they have already received a lab coat.

Space is limited; therefore, the adventurer will be added to the roster once we receive the registration and payment. If the roster is full when the payment is received, a refund will be issued.

Payments: When registering for multiple adventures, you may pay in full for the enrolled adventures or pay for the first adventure at the time of enrollment, to reserve the spots for the additional adventures.

Payments for the additional adventures are due 5 days before the upcoming adventure. If payment is not received and there is a waiting list, the next student on the waiting list will be notified of the opening.

Be sure to note the member's name and school in the memo section.

Adventure fee adjustments will not be made for student absences. Once a child is enrolled in the summer science adventure, their spot has been reserved; therefore, there will not be any refunds for missed classes.

N.S.F. Checks: In the event that your payment is returned, there will be a \$35 fee added to your account balance. A returned check must be paid with a cashier's check, money order, or cash.
